Creating boundaries for mobile phone

Parents and caregivers may be more inclined during summertime to allow children to use mobile phones, especially when school is not in session. Consider the following tips to establish boundaries and help keep children safe when using a mobile phone:

- Contact service provider to block internet access and calls from unapproved phone numbers.
- Designate certain times that cell phone must be turned off (family meals, school hours, after 10 p.m.)
- Insist that parental permission is required for the download of any and all apps.

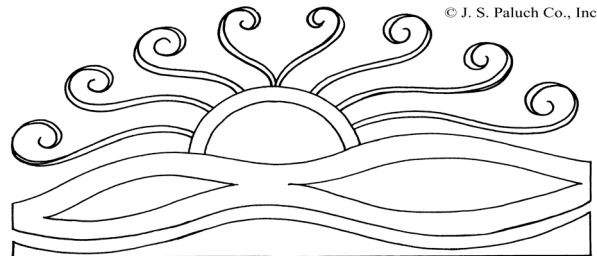
