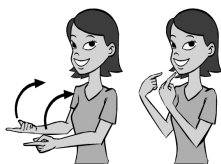
This year's Vacation Bible Camp (VBS) will be held at

Why do we have to attend Mass every Sunday?

Throughout our two thousand years of Church history,
 Sunday has been set aside as “the Lord’s Day,” to
 celebrate God’s greater creation of the world. According
 to the *Catechism of the Holy Church*, “The Sabbath
 brings everyday work to a halt and provides a respite. It is
 a day to protest against the servitude of the world and the
 worship of money” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*,
 #2172). Observing Sunday as the Lord’s Day helps us to
 keep our worship of God outward, visible, public, and
 regular. Sunday is also the day we celebrate Jesus’ resur-
 rection. The Church instructs us to attend Mass each Sun-
 day because that is where Jesus gives us what we need to
 stay strong in the world. Just as we take food into our
 bodies, so we take in Christ through the Eucharist. His
 body is real food and his blood is real drink (John 6:55-
 57). The resulting grace helps us to overcome our daily
 temptations and fulfill our
 responsibilities. Our faithful Communion will bring us
 eternal life.

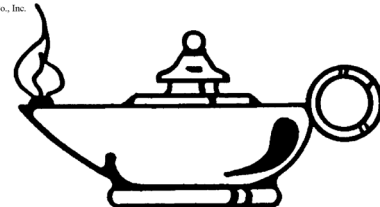

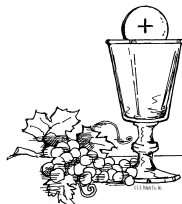
To All Parishioners:
